



## Billy G. Snow

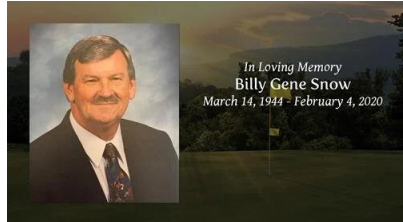
March 14, 1944 - February 4, 2020
