Flavil Hall Roberts, Jr. was born on March 18, 1930, in Jacksonville, Alabama to Bonnie Don Payne Roberts and Flavil Hall Roberts. He lived in many parts of the United States before finally settling in Kimberly, AL with his wife, Hazel Stamper Ernst Roberts, who has preceded him. Flavil was a longtime member of Slackland Baptist church in Leesburg, AL before joining Sardis Baptist Church in Kimberly, AL.
