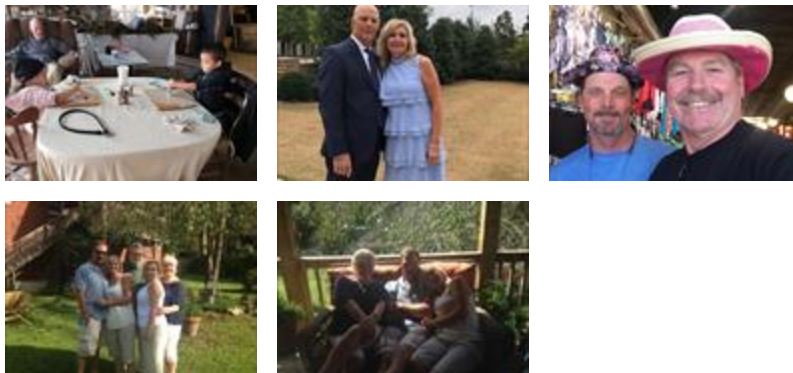
I want his family to know that I really liked and respected Jeff and I am so sorry to hear of his passing. Jeff made an impression on me and his family should be proud of him. I know they are.

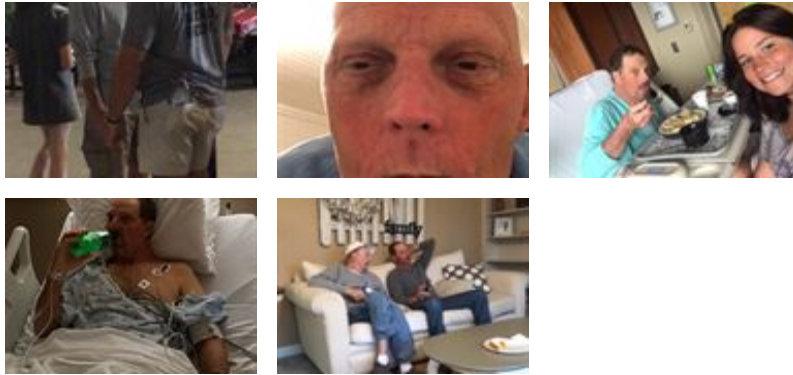
