Jimmie A. Trotter was born on September 17, 1937 and passed away on October 25, 2023. He was preceded in death by his parents, Lecil K. and Kathleen Trotter and his brother Ray. Jimmie is survived by his wife of 67 years, Joan Trotter, and daughters, Terri Nelson (Randy) and Carol Chatham (Kerry). Grandchildren: Rebecca Maniscalco (Brandon), Parker Nelson (Jordan), Morgan Jackson (Jarrod), and Payton Morgan (Jason). Great grandchildren: Mackenzie Maniscalco, Wade Morgan, Callie Jackson, Walt Morgan, Kailyn Nelson, and Chapel Jackson. Jimmie graduated from Warrior High School in 1955. He continued his education at Howard College/Samford University, graduating in 1959. In the fall of 1959, Jimmie began his career as an educator at Mortimer Jordan High School. He taught and coached at Mortimer Jordan for 38 years, with a short time away as assistant principal at EB Erwin High School under his mentor Bartow Hughes. Then, he was named principal at Hewitt Trussville for one year before answering the call to “come home” to Mortimer Jordan in the fall of 1968. Jimmie taught science, PE, and coached football, basketball, and baseball throughout his career. Teaching was his joy, coaching was his passion, mentoring and loving people was his calling. The values and ideals that he lived by were simple: love others, stand up to adversity, and at the end of the day always do the right thing. He knew some people didn’t understand, but he did. He knew that good and right will stand the test of time. Jimmie finished well, always leaning on God’s amazing grace, as he spent his final years surrounded by family, friends, and

communities that loved him dearly and will continue his legacy. Funeral services will be Saturday, October 28, 2023 at 11:00 AM at Church of the Highlands Fultondale Campus.
