John Erskin “Sonny” Little, 100, of Hoover passed away on Friday, September 19, 2025 at Brookwood Medical Center. He loved the craft of construction of which he was an artist.

John was a faithful Christian, devoted to the Lord in all things. God, family and country for 100 remarkable years.

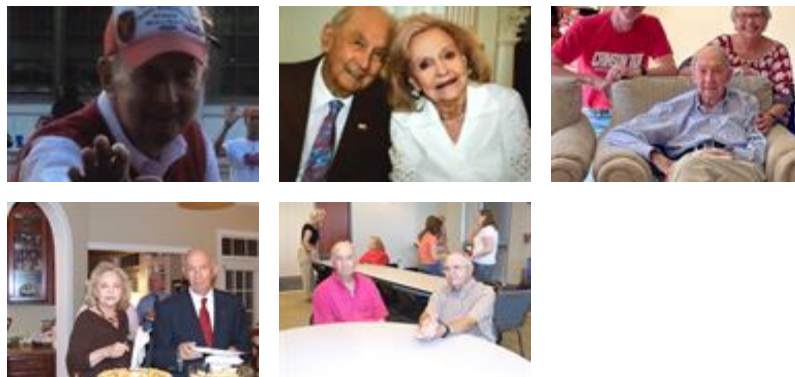
