Lee Carson Dobbs, age 73, of Warrior, passed away on Friday, July 8, 2011, after a lengthy illness.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Evie Dean Dobbs; and father, Willie Carl Dobbs. He is survived by his loving wife of 52 years, Betty Barnett Dobbs; two daughters, Donna Dobbs Bentley of Warrior, and Sandra Dobbs Watkins (Mickey); of Lake View; two grandsons, Braden and Matthew Watkins of Lakeview; one granddaughter, Amy Branyon Baker (Craven) of Las Vegas; one great-grandson, Charles Craven Baker, IV, of Las Vegas.

Lee was a graduate of St. Clair County High School and the School of Banking at Memphis State University. He began his career in banking at the First National Bank in Birmingham. In August 1970, he accepted a position with the Warrior Savings Bank and moved to Warrior. In July 1980, he was promoted to the position of executive vice president, and in January 1984 was elected president of the bank by the board of directors. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Warrior and was active in the Lions Club for over 35 years, where he served as District Governor, Chairman of the Council of Governors and President of Alabama Sight Conservation Association.
