ROBBINS, PAUL HUFF, of Birmingham, Alabama passed away May 6, 2007, at the age of 91 at Birmingham. He was born November 13, 1915 at Banner Mines, Alabama in west Jefferson County. He is preceded in death by his parents, William Walton Robbins, Sr. and Mattie Lou Huff Robbins, Sisters, Elsie Robbins Oglesby, Dorothy Robbins Bryan, and Kathleen Robbins Barnes Wyatt, brothers, William Walton (Bill) Robbins, Jr. and Charles Edward Robbins. Mr. Robbins helped organize and was the first president of Blountsville Lions Club, Past president of Warrior Lions Club, Anchor Boat Club, Vulcan Good Sam Camping Club, Goodtimers Camping Club and past secretary of the Oneonta Civitan Club. He served as a member of The Board Of Appeals for the City of Gardendale for Seven Years. Mr. Robbins was a member of First United Methodist Church of Birmingham for 57 years where he was a member of the Administrative Board and presently a member of the Honorary Administrative Board. He is past president of the George R. Stuart Sunday School Class, The Stuart-Blackwell Class and the Supper Club. He

also was a member of the George R. Stuart Men Chorus.
