Ray Otto Miller, a resident of Mount Olive, AL age 86, born March 2, 1931, went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, July 11, 2017. Ray was often found early in the morning hanging with his friends at the local Jack's in Mount Olive, sipping on coffee and talking about the latest events. He attended First Wesleyan Church, Birmingham, AL as well as Gateway Baptist in Fultondale, AL. Upon his death, he was a member of Gardendale First Baptist, Gardendale, AL. In his later years, Ray enjoyed traveling between Indiana and Florida hauling RV's, RV camping in Maggie Valley, North Carolina and St Augustine, Florida. He also served his country proudly in the Air Force as Staff Sergeant during the Korean War; Ray's job was to load the bombs onto the aircraft. He was decorated with a Korean Service Medal and UN Sv Medal and Nat Des Sv Medal.
