Mrs. Sherry Askew Ledlow, age 54 of County Line, passed away on Friday March 19, 2010. She was a member of County Line Baptist Church. She graduated from the University of Alabama at Birmingham with a bachelor's degree in 1986 and earned her masters degree in education. She was a 5th grade teacher at Bryan Elementary School in Morris for 23 years. During her tenure at Bryan Elementary she was the Lead Mentor, involved with The Honor Club and the Geography Bee. She was the creator of Bryan Bear at Bryan Elementary. Awarded the Second Mile teachers Award by her peers in 2008 and was named Teacher of the Year for 2007-2008. Reader's Digest honored her as one of the hero's of the bus wreck of Bryan Elementary School in the January 2008 issue. She was a member of the AEA, Daughters of the American Revolution, American Miniature Horse Association and Registry and she enjoyed genealogical research through Ancestry.com. Mrs. Ledlow is survived by her husband, Roger D. Ledlow; son, Jason C. Ledlow (Tori); daughter, Heather Ledlow Kratz; grandchildren, Joshua C. Ledlow and Caleb G. Ledlow; parents, Earl and Juanita Cato Askew. She also loved her beloved pet dog Gracie. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday March 23, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at County Line Baptist Church with Rev.
