



William Michael Brent Watkins

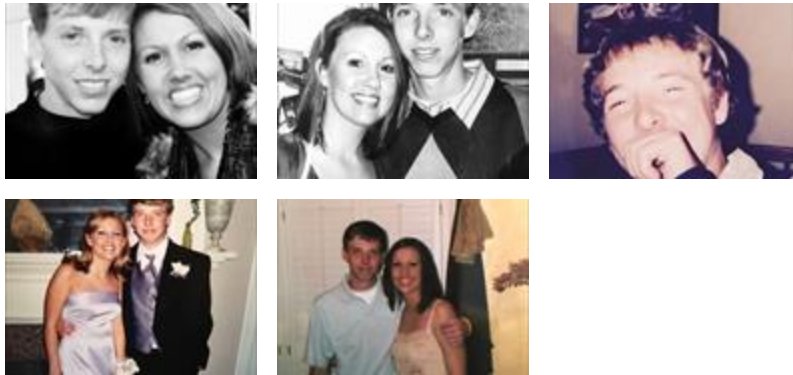
