William Chad Warnock was born October 30, 1980 and passed away from a heart attack on September 14, 2022 at the age of 41.

After completing high school Chad's love of country and desire to help and protect others lead him to join the U. S. Army shortly after 9/11 where he fought with the elite 5th Group Special Forces out of Fort Campbell Kentucky. He received multiple metals, accommodations and decorations for his bravery and valor fighting in the Iraqi Freedom Campaign and was retired honorably from the Wounded Warrior Project on April 28, 2011.

Chad loved Alabama football, Braves baseball, lake life, hanging out with family and friends, motorcycles, RC racing and his dogs. He was good with his hands and could fix just about anything.

Chad wants to be remembered for his love of country, helping others and does not want to be mourned but celebrated in his passing.
